With the addition of the cordless irons and cutting mats purchased with this BEF grant, safety was increased in the Family and Consumer Sciences classes at BHS. The cords on the irons serve as tripping hazards and students have previously knocked the irons to the floor. The new cordless irons are safer and increase efficiency of the students. With the cutting mats, the non-slip ruler grips prevent the students' quilting rules from slipping while using the rotary cutters. These materials are used for many projects in the classroom from their patchwork lanyards and pajama pants to their favorite group project, the BEF t-shirt quilt, that is made annually for the BEF gala silent auction.
