I have been personally changed by the Brownsburg Education Foundation grants through my Fashion and Textiles class at Brownsburg High School. These grants made it possible for my teacher to purchase embroidery & felting machines, Cricut machines, irons, and sewing kits. I began this class unable to sew or use any of these machines. Having completed this experience, I can now make masks, pants, and recycled clothing from the over 70 hours of classroom time. Sewing on buttons, making pockets, and sewing on a zipper are also valuable skills that I learned. During my experience, I also had opportunities to use these skills to support the community by making masks for the elderly and low-income veterans. This has meant a lot to me, as I have personally seen my skills make a difference.
