Grant Committee

Chair Paul Shaffer, Co-Chair Ryan Morrison and Members Beth Grant, Tiffany Dearman, Lindsey Catellier, Lori Medjeski and Chris Floyd.

The committee met to review the Incredible Award application on Wednesday, August 24th. We received 17 grant requests totaling \$26,568.48, not considering replication costs. The committee used a rubric to evaluate the grant application. The InCredible Award grants for 2022 will be \$18,765.67 which was under our budget by \$3,749.33. The remaining funds will be carried over to 2023.

During the grant review process, it was observed that all but three submissions were from middle and high school applicants. This was chalked up the replication requirements which makes elementary requests more challenging. It seems the District Excellence Award (DEA) grants may have become a better fit for those requests. We decided as a committee to evaluate each grant program to determine if future modifications are appropriate. Our first step in this process will be to meet with the building representatives after the next BEF meeting to seek feedback on the application process and criteria.
