This grant purchased items such as pillows, a bubble tube, light tiles, a lighted fan and an LED projector so that a fully equipped sensory room could be just steps away from the life skills classrooms. A sensory room provides physical and mental stimuli for children with physical disabilities, developmental delays and sensory impairments. For children with physical disabilities, interaction with sensory stimuli can help them to develop their sight, sound, touch and hearing, as well as encourage independence. Special education needs come in many forms, but sensory rooms can adapt and cater to a wide range of learning needs and physical requirements. Sensory rooms provide a therapeutic environment for children with autism and other special educational needs.
