Adapted toys and materials allow preschool and Pre-K students of all physical abilities to independently engage in play-based learning, which is the primary vehicle for developing foundational communication and cause-and-effect skills at this age. Without these resources, students with limited physical abilities must wait for adult assistance to activate toys, creating barriers to independent learning and development. This grant purchased toys and switches that allow students to operate these items by themselves. Beyond accessibility, incorporating these materials into all preschool classrooms also creates an opportunity to foster inclusion and acceptance among young learners from the start
